

M/S Enköping



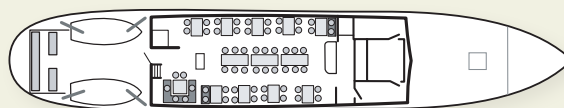
M/S Enköping was built in 1868 and, according to the Lloyds Register of Shipping, this makes her the world's oldest passenger ferry still in service. In Strömma's hands, she has undergone an extensive refit, with two sumptuous dining rooms on board as well as a wonderful sundeck. M/S Enköping still retains its typical Mälårboat profile, with a long foredeck that is ideal for welcome drinks, and on the open aft deck you can watch the sun setting over the water.

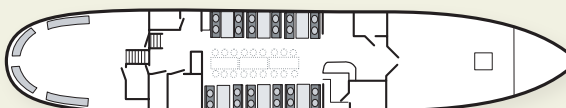
