

M/S Gustafsberg VII

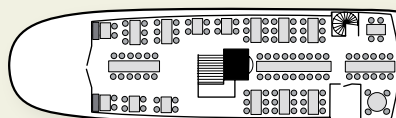

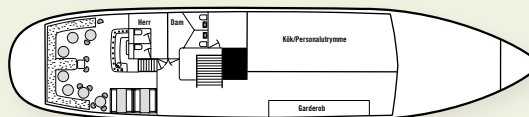
