As one of the last remaining ships that used to ply Lake Mälaren, M/S Prins Carl Philip has a fascinating history. At the beginning of the last century, she transported Stockholm's convicts out to the prison on Svartsjö. The convicts were chained to the main deck, while the first-class guests enjoyed fine dining inside. On the way to the capital, the ship was also loaded with vegetables from the farmers around Lake Mälaren, for sale to the citizens of Stockholm.

M/S Prins Carl Philip has a large and welcoming dining room on the upper deck and a sundeck that is perfect for pre-dinner drinks. Not surprisingly, the ship's godfather is Prince Carl Philip.

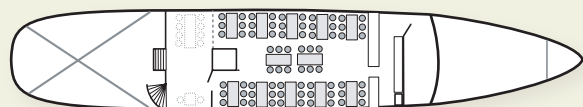
