

M/S Waxholm III



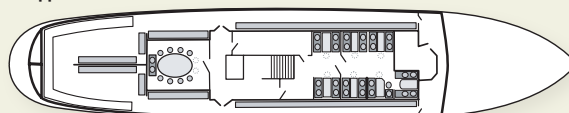
M/S Waxholm III is the last of the old archipelago ships to bear the name Waxholm. She has been lovingly renovated, and the interiors have been reinstated to give the feel of entering a restaurant in the early 20th century.

The ship has a gentlemen's lounge and a ladies' lounge, where wallpaper from the beginning of the 1900s was used as part of the refurbishment. The large sundeck is perfect for welcome drinks, while the beautifully inviting dining room on the main deck can accommodate over 100 people.

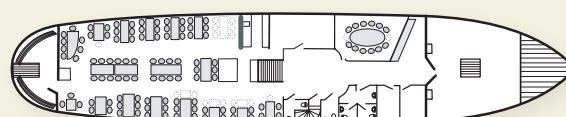
