10:45

12:00

M/s Waxholm IIII arrives at Kymmendö. Guided tour through the milieu that inspired August Strindberg to write, "Hemsöborna" (People of Hemso).

12:55

M/s Waxholm IIII departs from Kymmendö. The ship will sound its horn 5 minutes before departure. The second lunch sitting is served in the main dining room.

13:20 - 14:30

Afternoon coffee is served from the gangway bar.

14:10

The main dining room closes.

14:30

M/s Waxholm IIII arrives at Bullerö. A visit to the museum and a guided tour on a nature or culture trail. Overnight accommodation available.

15:20

M/s Waxholm IIII departs from Bullerö. The ship will sound its horn 5 minutes before departure. "Happy ship" in the ship's bar.
